VP's Corner.....with Ed Smoot

Man, summer is getting away from me! I remember watching June creep up on the calendar, thinking how quickly summer would be upon us....and in the blink of an eye, it's just about August!

Although the temps have been through the roof, I (along with help from the guys at our shop) have still managed to make some headway on a couple of things.

First and foremost, we've really been pushing to get the '68 rolling. And when I say "push", that's exactly what we did. Being in the RV industry, summertime is our busy season. In an effort to





get my '68 Malibu into a cruising state of mind, we kind of rushed things a bit. The car is painted now, and I'd say it's a good 5-footer. (A big improvement from my usual 10-footer!) We missed a few dents, and the body work has a few ripples in it, but hey-- this was meant to be a low-buck driver. It's the factory correct color- Butternut Yellow- and shortly will have a black vinyl top on it-- just like the day it was born. So, before you put the laser-eye down the side and feel compelled to point out a spot we missed, trust in the fact that I know...I know. That being said, I still love this car and can't wait to drive it to some club events.

I've also got a couple of side projects going- one I will talk about here, and one that will have to wait until next month. The one that I can speak about is regarding one of my favorite tow vehicles. Shortly after President Verstraete and I took office way back when, we acquired matching '07 Tahoes. Same color, same drivetrain, but the Prez opted for the light interior, while I got the dark. I will say that Roger seems to have treated his truck with a little more care than I have- while his gets regular washings and oil changes on a schedule, mine really gets little of that. I tend to tow trailers that far exceed what GM thinks the truck should pull, take the truck fishing, long haul to Canada multiple times hauling a payload, and basically just beat on it like a rented mule. And it shows. Earlier this year, I did have to replace the transmission (at 200k)- and at the same time upgraded the exhaust with long tube headers and hi- flow cats. Made here in KC, this is a belt driven supercharger that mounts on the front of the motor. The install is pretty straightforwardbasically removing the belt and re-configuring a couple of accessories to get this thing plumbed in. Mount the intercooler, replace the fuel injectors, and install the supplied tune via the handheld, and voila- Supercharged Tahoe!

I haven't really had a chance to pull with it yet, and the tune still needs a little tweaking, so I'll sure keep y'all posted on how it does.

I will not make this month's meeting- I'll be on a fishing trip back to Canada (can you say Beaumont?) with my boys....the good Lord only knows what I'll find this trip.




