2021 Meeting Minutes

MID-AMERICA CHEVELLE CLUB MERRIAM, KS April 29, 2021 MINUTES

The meeting, located at Merriam Marketplace, Merriam, KS, was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chair Roger Verstraete. There were 32 persons present. Two new members were present, Keith Culbertson and Tim Cooper. Introductions were made by those present.

The September, 2020 meeting minutes were approved as submitted via newsletter.

Mr. Verstraete overviewed the actions during the months of October, 2020 through present. Actions included donation to Wreathes over America and cancelled Christmas Party.

Mr. Verstraete spoke about 2021 club actions. He noted that at this time, the Christmas party is scheduled for December 4, 2021 with location and costs pending.

New business was discussed which included upcoming 2021-2022 election of officers, budget vote for club activities and for the car show, and annual picnic. 

THE CLONE STORY



Hi! My name is Anna Hallouer and this is the story of my 1967 Malibu, lovingly referred to as The Clone. I don't usually name my cars, but Gene and I needed a way to tell which 67 Malibu we were talking about. I have always loved the lines of the 67. In 1995 I met the man of my dreams, then he told me he owned a 67 Malibu....BONUS!!! Sometime in the early 2000's, MACC was invited to I-70 Speedway in Odessa, Mo. It was a long trip on a very hot day. With black vinyl interior and no A/C, I was a sweaty mess by the time we got there. After that trip I started making comments about needing AC in the car. My comments were usually met with, NO. Then no, I'm not cutting holes in my original dashboard. Then, we'll have to buy another car for A/C...getting closer. At one point he wanted me to buy a 69 that had A/C and disc brakes, no offense, but I'm not a big fan of 68-69. So I was told to start looking for 71-72 with A/C, disc brakes, and a small block. I already knew 70 was out of my price range. I looked for years, Craigslist, FB Marketplace, and other internet classic

car venues. I'd find a great one and was told we aren't ready to buy yet....really?? After I retired, and as winter crept up on us, he was finally ready to pull the trigger. I think he was looking for something to do this winter, since his car is pretty much completed, lol. Parameters given to me? Anything with A/C, disc brakes, small block, preferably a 700R4, NO body work needed, within a specified \$\$, and within 100+/- miles of KC . I love a challenge! After looking extensively every night, I finally got it down to 2 different 66 convertibles, one in Wichita, and one in Chicago (the search area had to grow). Gene is talking to Roger about heading out to see these cars this weekend when Roger says to check out this 67 on FB in KCK. What car in KCK? I did everything to find this elusive car in KCK on FB Marketplace and could never get it to come up. Roger sent us the info and we set up a time to go see it on Friday. This car met everything we were looking for, minus my convertible top, can't have it all, I guess.

The history we have on the car: She was born in Fremont CA. Originally Ermine White with Bright Blue interior, bucket seats, console, and factory AC. Her heart was a 327 with 2 speed Power Glide. She lived in New Mexico for a while before being sold and moved to Colorado. In 2018 she went from Ermine White to Marina Blue. Apparently, her heart wasn't strong enough because this owner replaced it with a 350 crate engine and 700R4 tranny. This is when she went from a 'Plain Jane' Malibu to a 'Stunning' SS. This process included new rear quarter panels, new front disc brakes, and MOST of the SS trim package including the hood. After all this she was sold the last part of 2018 and moved to Kansas City KS. This owner retrofitted her with a Vintage Air system, a March serpentine belt system, new tires and wheels, posi-track 3:31 rear end, and new interior except for the headliner. Sadly, or luckily for me, he only owned her for 1 year before deciding to sell her.

We went to look at her in January, 2021. The only issue we saw was someone had tried to make it a SS without taking off the Malibu side trim and putting on the SS rocker panel trim. But the rest of the body was really good (NO RUST!) and we weren't changing it back. We take this beauty to the 'infamous' John (and Steve), aka Midwestern Mechanical Specialties, for its first inspection. As John and Gene were walking around under this car pointing out all the flaws, I was following with paper and pen in hand to list said flaws. One entire page of things to be fixed, updated or improved emerged. At home, as we tried to check off what we had done, we found other things and that list quickly grew to 2 complete pages. Three months later, and another \$5000 from the bank, The Clone is finally road worthy. On April 28, just in time for the 2021 car season to start. This coming winter we will start work to complete the interior. And, MAYBE, I'll convince him to put that freshly rebuilt L79 327, he has sitting in the garage, in The Clone since it's already badged that way. Wish me luck! Anna
