2022 Meeting Minutes

MID-AMERICA CHEVELLE CLUB HENDRICK CHEVROLET, MERRIAM, KS March 31, 2022 MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:25 p.m. by Chair Roger Verstraete, with 33 persons present. New members included Shane and Mindy Bell – 1971 SS; Herb Bouyack – 1968; Larry McMullen – 1974; and former WACO Vice-President (recently moved back to KC metro) – 1967 Malibu. Introductions of other members followed.

At request of Secretary, the minutes were amended to note corrected member Chuck Doyle, and at request of Kirby DeMott, the name of the November Show in Chicago to "Muscle Car & Chrome Nationals." Minutes with amendments were accepted.

Mr. Verstraete informed those present that Superior Chevrolet will be closing at 7:00 p.m. each evening until more inventory is available. All present agreed to use Minsky's for the April meeting.

All were informed of the events from the recent World of Wheel's Show, which included six (6) member's vehicles.

The budget was briefly discussed, and it was noted the summer annual picnic would be located at Shawnee Mission Park.

Mr. Smoot reviewed the September 2022 Midwest Regionals referring back to the events of 2016 for comparison, with 160 cars registered. Sponsors for this year's event include Nebraska Furniture Mart; Midwestern Mechanical; Haggerty; Hinshaws; Hendrick Chevrolet; O'Reilley's; and Gateway Classic Cars. It was noted with the three clubs, it looks that all is in good shape for the event. He noted there would be more door prizes, Friday night cruise and meal at Wyandotte Park. He requested members to continue passing out flier at upcoming event, and noted some would be sent to other clubs and Gateway Classic Cars in Olathe and St. Louis. Greg Hanson will be coordinating the 2023 Show in Omaha.

A reminder and discussion of Club Officer Election for 2022-2023 was had. It was stated all positions are open – contact an officer if interested; nominations will be accepted in April, followed by election.

Mr. Smoot informed those present that with the 103 active memberships, at 50 to 60 percentage (or more) of members participation at the September Show is encouraged.

Mr. Findley overviewed the show registration, which can be accomplished on-line for all events, which includes participant judging using a QR code. He noted this enhancement should be live at the beginning of April.

The Treasurer's report was reviewed and accepted. Mr. Hallouer indicated the club made a donation at John Jamison's mother's passing. He also informed the membership there are 104 active memberships.

Upcoming events were overviewed. All were informed/reminded of the club participation on April 30 at the Gateway Classic Cars event - at which MACC is the highlighted club.

Larry McMullen informed those present of the Blue Springs Cruise Night each second Saturday, which begins at 5:30 p.m. until dark.


