



Davis Hall in Wyandotte County Lake at the end of the cruise. On Saturday, participant judging will start at 8am to 1pm. There will be two different classes (stock and modify) for each year to have your car judged in. There will be specialty awards for all years and also there will be sponsor awards too. If you have attended our car show in the past few years, you know our awards are some of the nicest awards given out in the city and this year will be no different.





This year we are also using the latest judging hardware that you can use on your smart phone to pick your favorite cars if you chose to, or you can just use a paper ballot. For those who want their car judged by professional judges, we are offering 1,000 point judging too. There is an added fee for this. If you do the 1,000 point judging, you will receive a special plaque with your total judging score on it. You must pre-register before September 1st and we are limiting this to the first 25 cars only. Brian has included the car show flyer in this month's newsletter, or you can go to our web site to download it. You can also register online. I guarantee you do not want to miss out on this Chevelle car show. We should have around 150 cars from all over the country in attendance. In 2016, we had one guy trailer his car from Miami, Florida to attend. It's been three years since the last Midwest Chevelle Regional was held in the Midwest and everyone is eager to show off their cars. You don't want to miss out on seeing some of the nicest Chevelle's in the Midwest and help support the Mid America Chevelle Club. This event is free for the public to attend.
