One of our members has a Chevelle for sale. The car is not finished but is almost there. Here is some info on the car.

1971 all original metal. No rust in the frame, floors or the trunk. Has a 502bbc with I believe it is a th350 transmission. New exhaust all the way back, tubular arms, new bumpers front and back, new aluminum radiator, core support, body bushings, all locks and handles. Had SS dash, new front grill, complete bolt kit, newer interior door panels, seats and carpet. I have more but can't remember anything else. What I know it needs, rear parking lights, head liner, package tray, front calipers and a gas tank. Has a one gallon drag tank in it. I think they were going to drag it due to the fact it has a secondary brake pedal that only goes to the front wheels. What I was told is the 502 is a fresh rebuild.
