One or both can be pre-ordered on my chevelled.net website at <https://chevelled.net/calendar/index.htm> via either PayPal or credit card . Both are 8.5x11 folded and 11x17 opened and hanging. The smaller 8.5x13 (open) size of last year did not sell well so the larger 11x17 is the only size I ordered this year.
