However, David called and talked to Brent and they both decided that we don't need to fill it out because we always pay sales tax when we get things done at Docu-Plex.

Swap Meet:

Our assigned places were moved this year to Section H spots 6, 7, 8 and 9. This puts us in the round part of Century 2 in the center section just in front of the bleachers. Our move in time is Thursday March 7 at 9 AM. We are to enter from the Douglas street side. He usually reserves his spaces for the following year while at this event so he will need to decide quickly.
