Hey I just gotta share. When I put my car together I used a Edelbrock 1406 600 cfm carb that has served me well. After several tries to eliminate a dead spot from idle I decided to try something new. Edelbrock has a new kid on the block, it's the AVS2 Series Carburetor. After talking with Edelbrock tech support about their new AVS2 carb I decided to give one a try. As advertised the AVS2 takes Thunder Series Performance to a new level, and it did. The new AVS2 model 1906 carb has annular boosters that lay horizontal with eight equally spaced orifices that deliver better fuel atomization in place of the old style down leg boosters that I had on my old 1406. The new carb did eliminate my dead spot and increased my power from idle to cruising speed. I now have instant smooth throttle response when you step on the pedal, it is like I added fuel injection at a fraction of the price. Anyone need a used 1406. LOL Doug
