If anyone would like to donate some parts for the project here is a list of the items that are needed for the engine cart.

Radiator, both battery cables, gauges (under the dash type), starter, battery, switches (toggle & pushbutton), one wire alternator, water pump, pulley's, exhaust manifolds, flywheel with bolts, fuel line, small tank for fuel, electric fuel pump, heavy duty casters, v-belts, electric fan,

Yes, all we have is the cart to start with. 😊

In many cases some of the items will be provided by the person that wants to break in their engine because they will already have the parts bolted to it.
